The SS611: ISO 20022 Corporate-to-Bank Payment Initiation and Payment Status messaging standard provides message definitions for corporations / solution providers to initiate FAST or GIRO transactions to banks, covering credit transfer (fund transfer), direct debit (GIRO collection) and payment status.

It is adapted from the Common Global Implementation – Market Practice (CGI-MP) and the interbank FAST and Bulk Payment ISO 20022 message definitions.

With this standardisation, we aim to -

- promote the development innovative payment solutions,
- ease the development of payment gateway to bank, and
- reduce operation and maintenance of payment solutions

Participants will learn about the definition, usage and implementation of the newly defined ISO 20022 Corporate-to-Bank Payment Initiation and Payment Status messaging standard.
